	Students attending a four year institution may receive a \$2,500.00 payable directly to the College/University for tuition and books. Any major qualifies.
	Student must provide and submit with the scholarship application proof of enrollment in a four year College/University.
	Student must be enrolled with a minimum of 12 units at the time of the scholarship application.
	Student must have maintained a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher from all High Schools attended.
	Student must be a legal resident of the State of California for at least one year prior to the date of application and have a valid California Driver's license or California State Identification card. Please attach a copy of the CA Driver's License or ID card.
	Two letters of recommendation must be submitted with the application, including one from a Teacher, Advisor or Coach of attending High Schools and one letter of recommendation from the FAR REALTOR® Sponsor.
	A typed essay of no more than 300 words expressing your career objectives.
	An official transcript from all High Schools attended must be submitted with this application.
